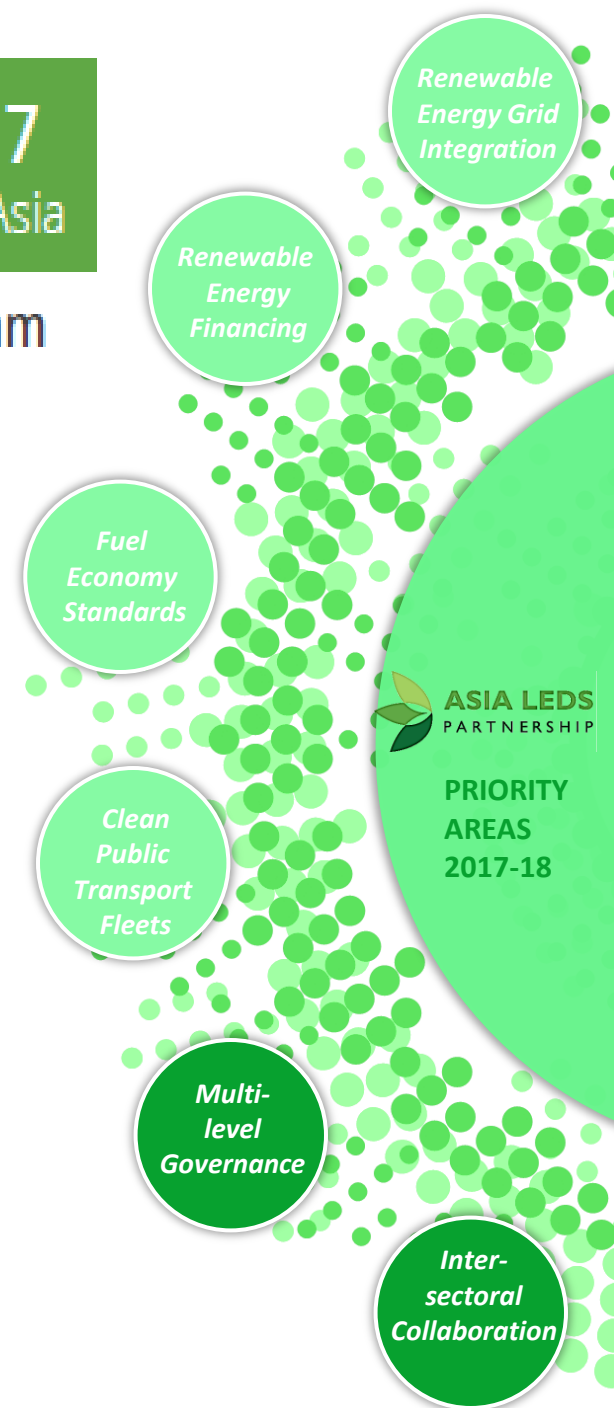

Objectives

- To highlight the importance of the transparency regime within the context of the Paris Agreement and reveal the links between NDC implementation and transparency
- Further explore how climate reporting and a robust, self-sustained MRV system can have different benefits for a country, in addition to fulfilling current and future reporting requirements under the UNFCCC. Such benefits can include tracking sustainable development goals, providing coherent data for national policy-making or increasing political buy-in
- Enhance the understanding of policy makers and other stakeholders as to why the establishment of MRV systems has merits of its own and how countries may tap such national benefits
