- **Launched in May 2010** by **South Africa**, **Republic of Korea** and **Germany**
- **Global network** of climate policy makers & practitioners
- **Aim:** promoting practical exchange and political dialogue between countries on enhanced transparency and, thus, facilitating growing ambition of partner countries
- **Activities:** Partnership Meetings, Annual Partnership Retreats, technical workshops in regional groups, web-based knowledge sharing etc.

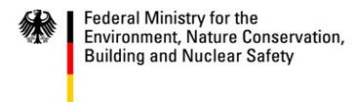
## Information Matters

### Transparency through Reporting

- **Goal:** Strengthen in-country capacities for enhanced reporting (BURs and NCs) of climate relevant information to UNFCCC
- Support for 9 **partner countries:** Chile, Colombia, Dominican Republic, Georgia, Egypt, Ghana, Viet Nam, Philippines
- **Activities:**
  - Identification of specific needs and priorities of the MRV systems and GHG monitoring in the partner countries
  - Provision of tailored-made capacity-building trainings and backstopping as well as concepts for institutionalization
  - Support through peer-to-peer exchange and development of knowledge products
