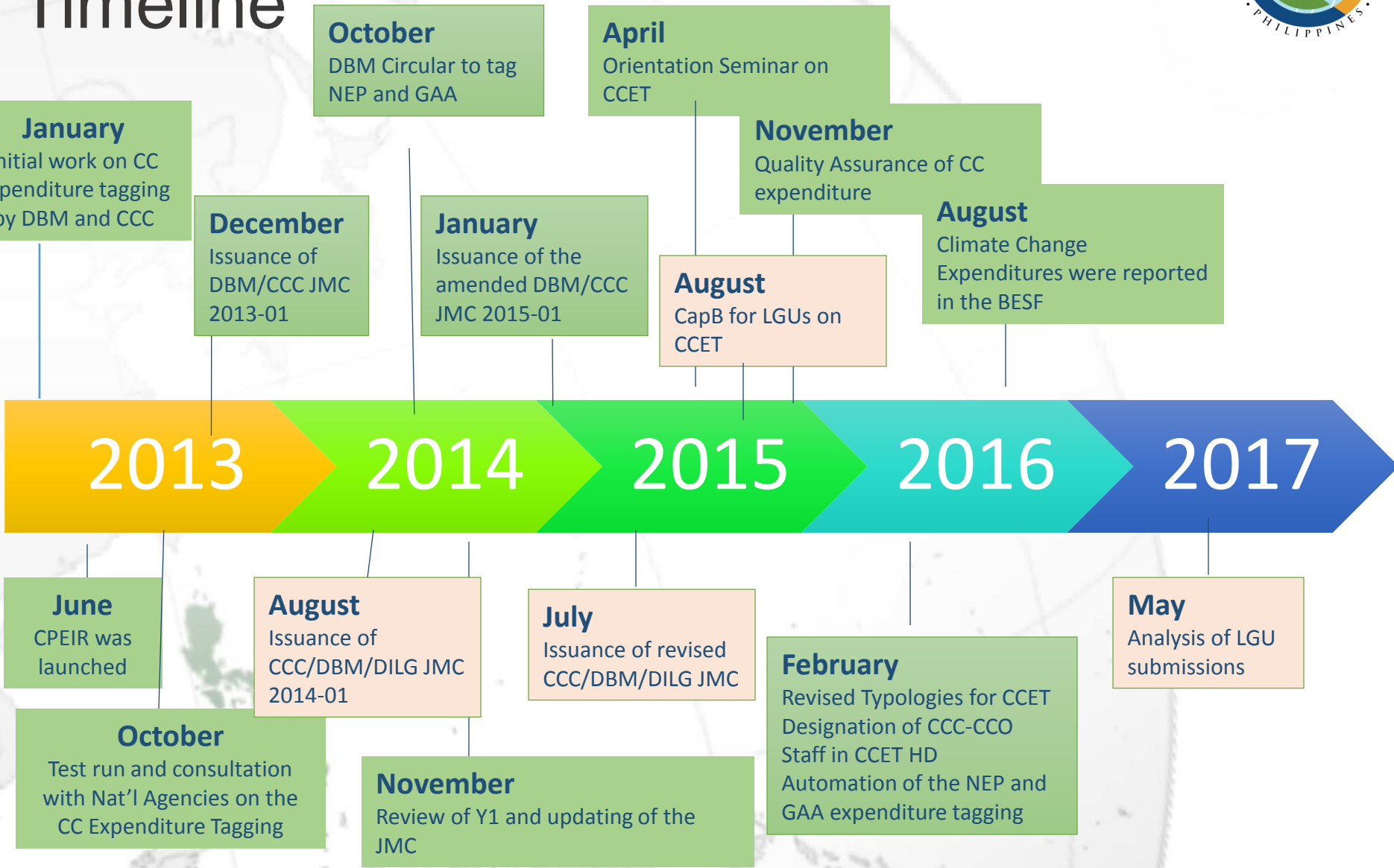

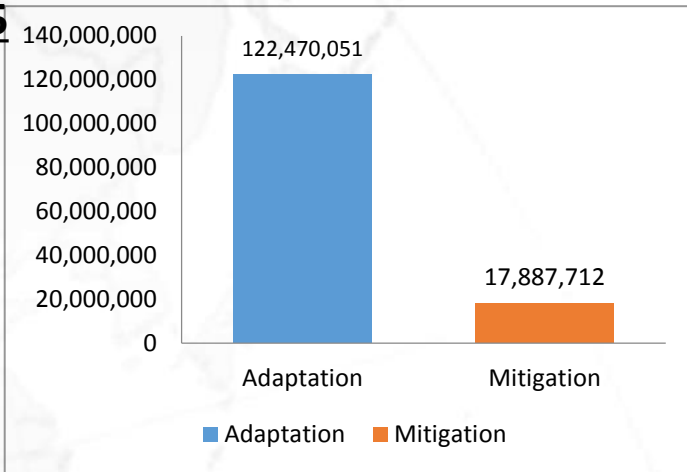

Philippine Climate Budget Tagging Timeline

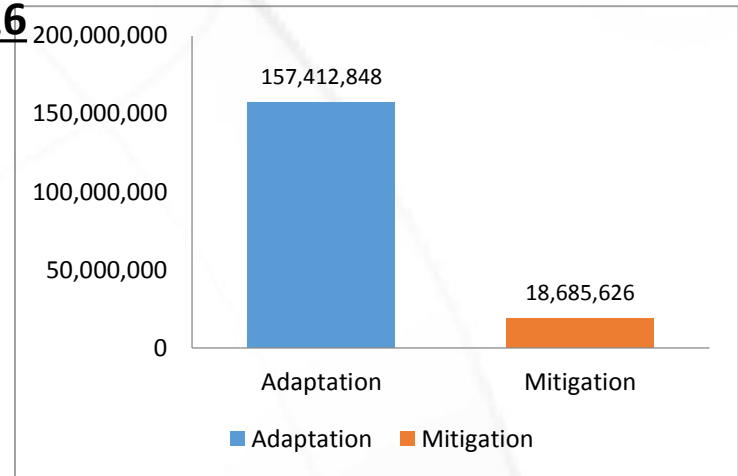

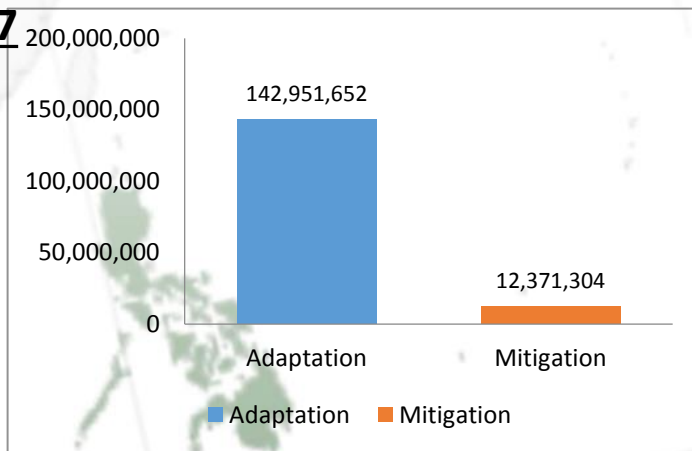

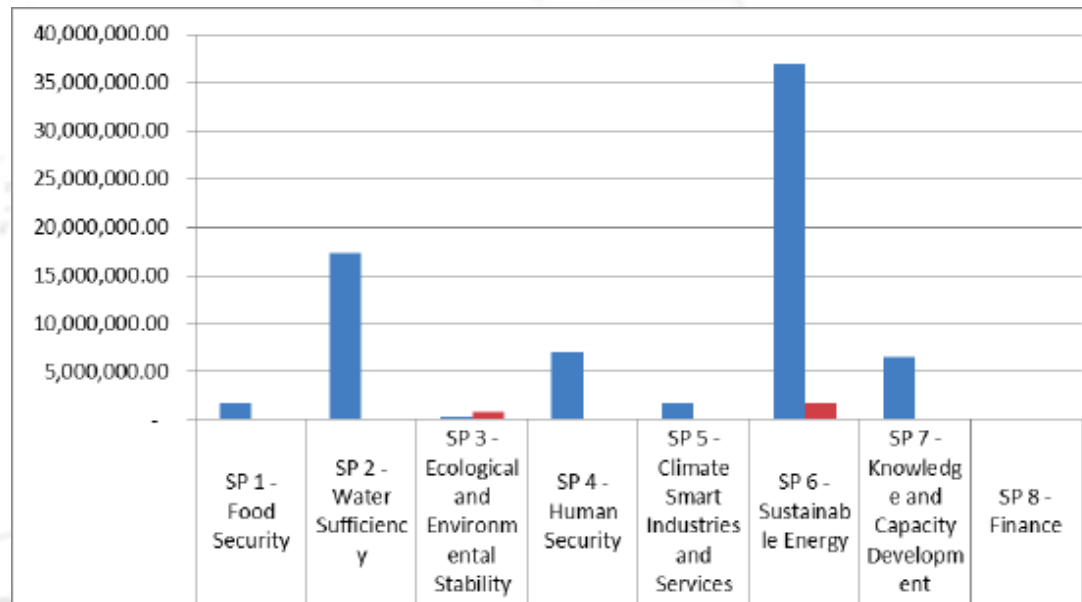
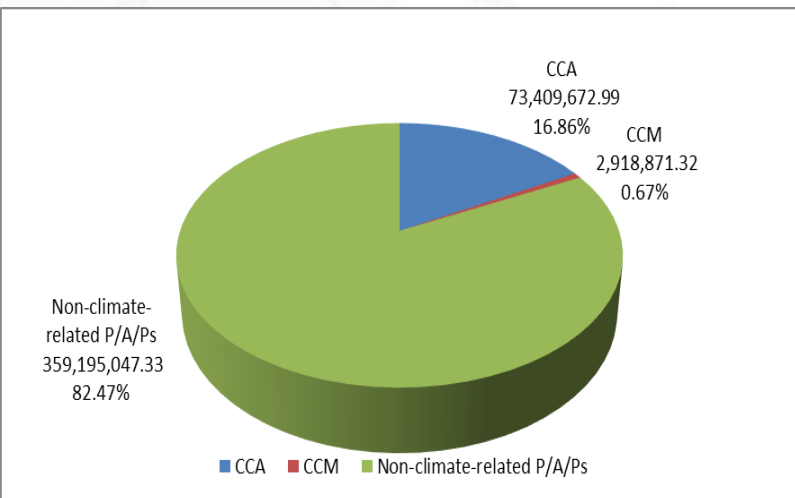
